He currently serves on the editorial board of Chemical Geology, the journal and the European Association of Geochemistry, has been a member of the association's board of directors, and chairs The Geochemistry of The Earth Surface (GES), a working group of the International Association of GeoChemistry. He is the chairman of the Scientific Steering Committee for the carbon sequestering in basaltic rocks initiative; Carb-fix.
